An Act relating to children; creating the Children of Incarcerated Parents Task Force; providing for membership; directing how vacancies should be filled; providing for subcommittees; requiring final written report; specifying date of report; providing for termination of Task Force; requiring organizational meeting; providing for selection of chair and vice-chair; specifying meeting frequency; providing for staff assistance; prohibiting travel reimbursement; permitting use of public and private resources; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Children of Incarcerated Parents Task Force

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section <Section No.> 601.20 of Title <Title No.> 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created the Children of Incarcerated Parents Task Force to recommend to the Legislature and other policymakers measures that promote the safety and well-being of children whose parents are incarcerated.

- B. The task force shall be composed of twenty-one (21) members as follows:
- 1. The Director of the Department of Human Services, or designee;
- 2. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs, or designee;
 - 3. The State Commissioner of Health, or designee;
- 4. The Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, or designee;
 - 5. The Director of the Department of Corrections, or designee;
- 6. OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR dent of Public Instruction, or designee;

The task force shall submit to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives a report no later than January 1, 2012, that identifies services to children of incarcerated parents that promote their safety and well-being. The task force shall terminate by operation of law on February 1, 2012.
- F. The report by the task force shall reflect the goals, outcomes, and recommendations of the seven subcommittees established in subsection D of this section.
- G. The Task Force shall hold an organizational meeting not later than September 1, 2011. The task force shall elect a chair and vice-chair at the first meeting. The task force shall meet at least once monthly. $\bf OFFICE$ OF THE GOVERNOR
