An Act relating to revenue and taxation; creating the Task Force for the Study of State Tax Credits and Economic Incentives; providing for membership of Task Force; requiring organizational meeting; providing for quorum; providing for cochairs; requiring study of certain tax credits; providing for study of economic incentives; defining scope of study; providing Task Force subject to certain statutory provisions; providing for staff assistance; requiring final report; providing for termination of Task Force; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Task Force for the Study of State Tax Credits and Economic Incentives

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section <Section No.> 2357.1A-1 of Title <Title No.> 68, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created the Task Force for the Study of State Tax Credits and Economic Incentives.

- B. The Task Force shall consist of ten (10) members to be appointed or selected as follows:
- 1. The Chair of the Appropriations and Budget Committee of the Oklahoma House of Representatives;
- 2. The Chair of the Appropriations Committee of the Oklahoma State Senate;
- 3. The Chair of the Revenue and Taxation Subcommittee of the Appropriations and Budget Committee of the Oklahoma House of Representatives;
 - 4. The Chair of the Senate Finance Committee;
 - 5. The Director of the Office of State Finance or a designee;
 - 6. The State Treasurer or a designee; OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR
 - 7. The Oklahoma Secretary of State or a designee; Received by the Governor this
 - day 8 of Minority Leader of th20 Oklahoma House of Representatives;
 - at 9. Minority o'Cleaker of the OM ahoma State Senate; and
 - 10. The State Auditor and Inspector.

- C. The Task Force shall conduct an organizational meeting not later than September 30, 2011 A majority of the members present at the organizational meeting or any subsequent meeting shall constitute a guorum for the purp 29e of stany action ordecten including the preparation and approval of the final report required by subsection I of this section.
- D. The cochairs of the Task Force shall be the member who is the Chair of the Revenue and Taxation Sub Governor of the State of Akshorations and Budget Committee and the member who is the Chair of the Finance Composition of the State of th
- Received by the Secretary of State this The Task Force shall be authorized to meet as necessary in order to perfagy of the duties imposed upon it. Legislative members of the Task Force shall be reimbursed for travel expenses pursuant to the provisions of the Task Force shall be reimbursed as provided by the appointing authority.

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- F. The Task Force shall conduct a study regarding all state tax credits regardless of the tax type against which such credit may be claimed and any other economic incentives that affect state or local tax liabilities. The study shall include, but shall not be limited to:
- 1. The justification for the enactment of any state tax credits based upon the relevant economics of the applicable industry or economic sector affected;
- 2. The economic impact related to the utilization of state tax credits;
- 3. Analysis of the utilization of the credits by tax credit purchasers;
- 4. The impact of tax credits on any and all economic sectors of the ${\tt stat}$ **GOVERNOR**

- H. Staff assistance for the Task Force shall be provided by the staff of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the State Senate.
- I. The Task Force shall produce Governor of the State of Oklahomo f its findings and any recommendations regarding transferable tax credits. The OFFICE THE ISECRETARY OF STATE the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the State by the Secretary of State this than December 31, 2011.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective <Enter Effective Date > July 1, 2011.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
