An Act relating to physician licensure; amending 59 O.S. 2011, Sections 509, as last amended by Section 8, Chapter 492, O.S.L. 2019 and 637, as amended by Section 31, Chapter 363, O.S.L. 2019 (59 O.S. Supp. 2019, Sections 509 and 637), which relate to unprofessional conduct; broadening certain definitions to include certain acts; amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-731, which relates to abortion; prohibiting issuance or renewal of physician license for certain acts; requiring State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision and State Board of Osteopathic Examiners to revoke licenses for certain acts; providing exceptions; directing promulgation of rules; directing Office of the Attorney General to calculate certain costs; requiring reporting of certain records; and providing for codification.
