




Phase 1 Pre-Pandemic





March - August 2020




Benefits Paid from 2009-2020




Phase 2 Pandemic Timeline


March - August 2020



Benefits Paid Out Comparison




Initial Claims Comparison






Potential Employer Impact



Loan Status

Currently in place across **21 states**, including Colorado, New Mexico and Texas.



\$25M Trigger for the Trust Fund

If \$25M trigger is met an up-to 33% surcharge is assessed and applied immediately to replenish the fund.


72% = .03%

Employer Rate Increase

Updated for Oklahoma employers for 2021.
Majority of employers **won't** see a significant increase.
