FY 2021 Budget Summary

Accomplishments

- First robotic surgery performed in August 2020
- Successfully partnered with Oklahoma State University, the Veterans Administration, the City of Tulsa, and the State of Oklahoma to receive congressional funding for the construction of a new VA hospital in downtown Tulsa
- Continued trend of increasing the Medicare Value Based Purchasing Total Performance Score, moving closer to the national median
- Addressed deferred maintenance needs by initiating project to replace bed tower windows and building façade
- Completed comprehensive academic medical campus master plan

Accomplishments & Strategic Initiatives

Strategic Initiatives

- Operating room construction & robotic surgery service line startup
 - \$19,845,481 construction and robotic surgery equipment
 - \$4,973,513 provided in FY 2021
 - \$14,871,968 remaining need
- Conversion of patient care rooms to single occupancy with negative pressure and ventilator capabilities and intensive care unit renovations
 - \$47,325,000 renovation estimate
- Strategic joint physician service line development with the Veterans Administration
 - \$15,043,000 capital and operating expenses over 3-year startup period
- Construction of a new mental health hospital in partnership with the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services and community donors
