

•Background:

- Agreement between TAG, Chancellor of Higher Education, and the Board of Regents in 1995
- Covers just Undergraduate Tuition not Fees
- Residence Requirement

• Goals of the Program:

• The Oklahoma National Guard Tuition Waiver is established as an incentive for qualified young men and women to join the Oklahoma National Guard and as a means to retain skilled, productive citizens within the state.

OKNG Tuition Waver History

•Administration:

- Administered by OMD & State Regents
- Universities are reimbursed with state appropriated funds based on the number of waived hours over a minimum based on undergrad enrollment (between 300 and 750)

Constitutiona I & Legislative Structure

70 O.S. Sec. 3218.8

Delegates authority to set **MANDATORY** fees and **TUITION** to State Regents subject to Big Twelve Peer Average Cap.


70 O.S. Sec. 3218.10

Oklahoma Constitution Article XIII-

Grants authority to sea tuition and fees to the Legislature

70 O.S. Sec. 3218

Delegates authority to set ACADEMIC SERVICES fees to each Institutional Board (i.e., OU Board of Regents) subject to State Regents approval, not capped.



Tuition & Fee Historical Increases






