



NEUs have received a login to sign up in the portal

NEUs are signed up on the portal and have accepted funds (No NEUs have declined funds)

NEUs have ARPA funds in their accounts

37 Million dollars distributed to 65 NEUs

- Completion of document verification and payment processing for NEUs signed up in the portal
- Continued communication to NEUs on completing signup
- Scale solution to remaining 250 NEUs

Preliminary Eligibility Review: Develop preliminary eligibility review process and rubric




**Phase 2 to build reports:** Develop public-facing reporting metrics regarding high-level submission statistics and process flow




Continuous Service Improvement: Evaluate potential improvements to the forms












- On 9/30, the U.S. Treasury communicated a deadline change for the Project & Expenditures Report
- For states and territories, the report will now be due on January
  31, 2022
- For non-entitlement units of government (NEUs), the Project and Expenditure report will now be due on **April 30, 2022**
