


FY'23 GA Bill Highlights

Education

- \$17,378,500 Higher Ed Teacher Shortage Employment Incentive Program
- \$1,500,000 Higher Ed Tulsa Reconciliation Scholarships
- \$9,000,000 SDE Increase for Activities
- \$401,906,190 Teacher Retirement System Including the amount in the GA Bill

General Government & Transportation

- \$15,000,000 ODOT Increased Funding for ROADS
- \$15,847,666 OMES Device-as-a-Service Funding
- \$28,237,000 OMES Service Oklahoma
- \$2,000,000 Aeronautics Increase to Operations
