The contractor prepared a draft request for proposal for the Courts to facilitate the hiring of a programmer to perform the work. The contractor also provided an estimate of the overall project cost. In addition to requesting ARPA funds, the Courts are seeking a partial grant from the OBF for this project. The ARPA application request is net of the estimated amount to be received from the grant.
