## First Extraordinary Session of the Fifty-ninth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

**Tenth Legislative Day, Monday, July 31, 2023**

The Senate was called to order by Senator Coleman.

### MESSAGES FROM THE HOUSE

Advising the signing of and transmitting for signature Enrolled **HCR 1002x**.

The above-numbered enrolled measure was properly signed and ordered returned to the Honorable House.

Returning herewith Enrolled **SB 26X**, together with the Governor's veto message thereon, and advising that under the provisions of Article VI, Section 11, of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma, the House of Representatives has reconsidered and passed said measure, over the Governor's veto, by a two-thirds vote of all members elected to and constituting the House, said vote being as follows - Ayes 72, Nays 16.
