The Dragonfly Home is Oklahoma's only state-certified* nonprofit dedicated *exclusively* to serving victims of human trafficking—including **sex and/or labor trafficking**—and the only state-certified program for human trafficking victims in Oklahoma City.

Since opening our Human Trafficking Crisis Center in 2016,** we have served over 800 victim-survivors of human trafficking and fielded over



8,000 calls to our 24h Human Trafficking Helpline. We walk alongside these strong, resilient individuals, providing support and services as they take steps toward building a new life!

The Dragonfly Home walks alongside human trafficking victim-survivors on their path to freedom and restoration.

Dragonfly Services

Human Trafficking Crisis Center

- Non-Residential services
- Crisis Intervention, Case Management, and Advocacy
- Emergency Relocation away from violent traffickers
- Counseling and Linkage to medical care, legal services, and more

24h Human Trafficking Helpline

- Crisis Intervention + Referral

Housing Assistance Program

- Rent and utility assistance for victims + their families in individual houses or apartments

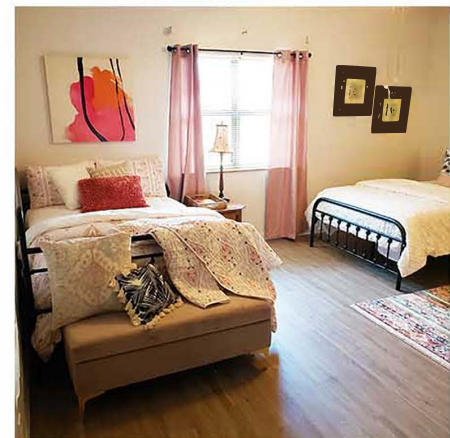
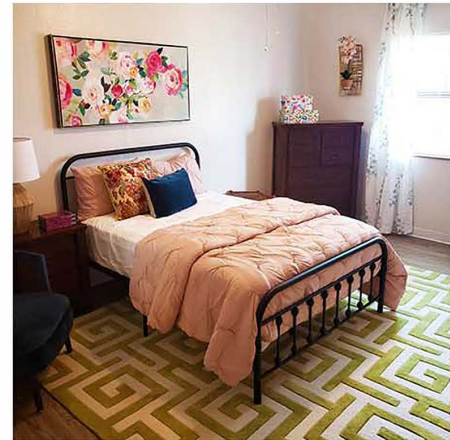
Human trafficking survivors and their children will take steps toward a new life in a supportive environment at The Dragonfly Human Trafficking Transition Home.

A safe, welcoming home. 24-hour care and advocacy. A place to reach for practical goals so they can create self-sustainability and build a new future.

At The Dragonfly Human Trafficking Transition Home, residents have access to:

- Safe place to stay, free of charge, for approximately 12-18 months (determined on case-by-case basis)
- Opportunity to build life skills, get an education, gain employment and save money for the future
- On-site Dragonfly advocates 24 hours a day
- Services provided at Dragonfly's Human Trafficking Crisis Center, including case management; linkage to professional services, support groups; and more
- Transportation to necessary appointments

The Dragonfly Human Trafficking Transition Home in Oklahoma City is Oklahoma's first ever state-certified transition home program for survivors of human trafficking and their children
