

### **Field Experience**

- Literacy Practicum/Tutoring, Pre-internship Practicum, Internship
- Collaboration with local schools
- Focus on building connection, application, and transfer
- Literacy Practicum/Tutoring
  - One-to-one tutoring
  - Twice weekly
  - Focus on five essential elements of reading (NRP) and writing
  - Assessments
  - Assessment-informed intervention lessons
  - Reflective practices

## Role of Teacher Education in K-3 Student Reading

- Teachers are the most critical factor in student success in reading.
- Teacher education helps pre-service teachers
  - systematically gain content knowledge and pedagogical knowledge for effective K-3 reading instruction for all children.
  - make connections between theory, research, and practice.
  - develop classroom management skills.
  - develop decision-making skills.
  - apply content knowledge and instructional practices in field experiences with support, supervision, and guidance.
  - become reflective practitioners striving to improve teaching and learning outcomes.

### Recommendations for Teacher Education Programs

- Intentional program design, development, and improvement informed by research and professional standards
- Ongoing professional development opportunities for reading faculty
- Adoption of research-based core and supplemental curriculum materials
- Modeling of research-based reading instructional practices in reading education coursework
- Strong field experience for practice and transfer
- Collaboration with parents, schools, and community groups to build alliances
- Collaboration with reading education colleagues across the state for program development and improvement
