Most nest predation was attributed to mesocarnivores raccoons, striped skunks, and **Virginia** opossums —but **American crows** and Feral Swine are predators, Widolife

Feral swine have decreased mortality and greater reproductive output when more resources are available









Wildlife Services



Probability of nest being depredated is >30% when feeders/bait stations are within 1 km







Managing local predator populations during nesting season has been proven to increase brood success
