**How would the agency handle a 2% appropriation reduction in FY'19?**

With 2% cut to appropriations, OEQA would cut \$32,398 in spending. The cuts would include one school performance review (\$35,000-\$50,000).

**How would the agency handle a 4% appropriation reduction in FY'19?**

With 4% cut to appropriations, OEQA would cut \$64,676 in spending. The cuts would include one school performance review (\$35,000-\$50,000), office supplies (\$4,000-\$6,000), printing (\$1,000-\$3,000), staff and consultant travel (\$2,000-\$3,000).

**How would the agency handle a 6% appropriation reduction in FY'19?**

With 6% cut to appropriations, OEQA would cut \$97,194 in spending. The cuts would include two school performance reviews (\$70,000-\$100,000), office supplies (\$4,000-\$6,000), printing (\$1,000-\$3,000), staff and consultant travel (\$2,000-\$3,000), and paper recycle (\$100 - \$600).

**Administrative Services**

The OK Educational Reform Act provides that the Secretary of Education, through OEQA, shall monitor the efforts of the public school districts to comply with the provisions of the OK Educational Reform Act and the OK Schools Testing Program Act., identify satisfactory progress toward compliance; recommend appropriate corrective action; analyze revenues and expenditures relating to compliance; give close attention to expenditures for administrative expense; make reports to the public concerning these matters when appropriate; make recommendations regarding funding for education or statutory changes whenever appropriate. OEQA publishes the "Profiles" series of reports at the district and school levels. The "Profiles" reports are the fulfillment of the charge given to the Educational Indicators Program. The purpose of OEQA is to "develop and implement a system of measures whereby the performance of public schools and school districts will be measured without undue reliance upon any single indicator, and whereby the public, including students and parents, may be made aware of the results of any tests administered under the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act, relative accomplishments of the public schools, and of the effectiveness and efficiency of the budget and operations of public schools. OEQA is authorized to conduct performance reviews to determine the effectiveness and efficiency of the budget and operations of public schools. OEQA is responsible for a performance based teacher preparation accreditation system: facilitates the accreditation process of all Oklahoma institutions which offer teacher education programs, conducts assessments of the teacher preparation units; conducts an independent review of teacher preparation programs; oversees the approval of licensure programs; provides training and support on accreditation and program standards; monitors program quality through annual reporting. In partnership with the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation Alliance for Educator Preparation, OEQA will facilitate the preparation of teachers through a clinically-based preparation model. OEQA oversees the Ed Leadership Oklahoma program which awards annual scholarships and provides guidance and support for teachers going through the National Board process and professional learning for candidates and National Board Certified Teachers. OEQA is responsible for developing and implementing a competency-based assessment system for educator licensure in the state. OEQA is responsible for the Teacher Certification Scholarship program.
