Second Regular Session of the Sixtieth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Sixteenth Legislative Day, Thursday, February 26, 2026

The Senate was called to order by Senator Howard.

HB 1411 – By Grego and Hill of the House and Hamilton of the Senate.

An Act relating to the True Grit Trail; directing the Department of Transportation to erect signage in certain locations; requiring the Department of Transportation to collaborate with the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department to maintain certain online resources for the True Grit Trail; providing source of funding; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

HB 3143 – By Cornwell, Turner, Lepak, Wolfley and Roberts of the House and Alvord of the Senate.

An Act relating to medical marijuana; amending Section 2, Chapter 342, O.S.L. 2022, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 168, O.S.L. 2023, and Section 2, Chapter 342, O.S.L. 2024 (63 O.S. Supp. 2025, Sections 427.14a and 427.14c), which relate to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection Act; modifying dates for moratorium; deleting requirement to review and process applications by certain date; updating internal effective dates; providing restrictions for submitting applications to transfer ownership of medical marijuana businesses; requiring completion of administrative actions or appeals prior to submitting transfer applications; establishing time limitation for submitting applications following license annulments, revocations, or suspensions; deleting time limitation and requirement for submitting new applications; deleting certain refund requirement; and providing an effective date.

HB 3144 – By Cornwell, Turner, Roberts and Wolfley of the House and Alvord of the Senate.

An Act relating to medical marijuana; amending 63 O.S. 2021, Section 422, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 447, O.S.L. 2024 (63 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 422), which relates to the licensing of medical marijuana commercial growers; restricting the number of certain licenses Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority may approve and issue to applicants; updating language; repealing 63 O.S. 2021, Section 427.14a, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 168, O.S.L. 2023 (63 O.S. Supp. 2025, Section 427.14a), which relates

to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection Act; and providing an effective date.

HB 3901 – By Hefner, Roe, West (Josh) and McCane of the House and Stanley of the Senate.

[psychological autopsy - Commissioner of Health - psychological autopsy examiner - pilot psychological autopsy service - report - exchange of information - rules - State Department of Health – codification - effective date]

HB 3981 – By Caldwell (Trey) and Bashore of the House and Gollihare of the Senate.

[District Attorneys Council - District Attorney Locality Incentive Program - minimum requirements – procedures - District Attorney Locality Incentive Program Revolving Fund – codification - effective date]
