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What is Personalized Learning?

Personalized learning is tailoring learning to meet each student's unique strengths, needs, interests, and goals. This includes enabling <u>student voice</u> and <u>choice in what, when, and how they learn</u> to provide <u>flexibility</u> and <u>supports</u> to ensure <u>mastery of the highest standards possible</u>. Personalized learning is an alternative to the so-called "one-size-fits-all' approach to schooling.



Technology- the flashy part of PL

Most schools use a learning management system (LMS) to provide personalized learning. Common LMS used in Oklahoma include:

- Odysseyware
- Edmentum
- Spark
- Summit Personalized Learning Platform

The LMS platforms are not synonymous with personalized learning. They are tools to enable personalized learning.



Challenges Implementing PL

- **Teacher challenge:** Paradigm shift from "sage on the stage" to "facilitator of learning"
- **Community Challenge:** Fundamental change in education is particularly difficult given our shared experience: "We're all education experts because we all went to school."
- **Student Challenge:** Student freedom can be empowering but it can also cause problems.
- **Funding:** This isn't typically a challenge but it gets a lot of attention. Yes, there are some technology costs associated with PL but these aren't typically huge. Some might consider PL to save costs and that's also wrong.
